We are delighted that this year's Annual Lecture will be given by Prof Mona Siddiqui. Professor Siddiqui

is well known internationally as a public intellectual and a speaker on issues around religion, ethics and public life. She is a regular commentator in the media, known especially for her appearances on BBC Radio 4 and BBC Radio Scotland's *Thought for the Day*.

In 2011, she was awarded an OBE for her interfaith work. She has spoken on religion and politics at the World Economic Forum in Davos and been listed in the Debrett's top 500 list of the most influential people in the UK. In April 2019, she received the Archbishop of Canterbury's Hubert Walter Award for Reconciliation and Interfaith Cooperation. In April 2019 she was elected a Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences and in December 2020, she was elected honorary member and first speaker of the Royal Scottish Academy. In October 2021, she was elected Vice-President International for the Royal Society of Edinburgh.
